#### **Fish Stocking Update**

Fish stocking is a balancing act. Our waters tend to be in better condition early in the season when temperatures are low and before weeds grow, die, and decay. For the past few years, we have stocked fish four times throughout the season. We've noticed the new arrivals seem to be more sensitive to mediocre water conditions and we get more fish kill. We've decided that during this dry period, we will stock fewer times and earlier in the season to take advantage of optimal conditions. We will evaluate as the season progresses.

The LPROA pond by Stagestop has no natural flow coming in so water has to be pumped while Lost Park Ranch is in priority. With the current drought conditions, it is not known if Lost Park will be in priority long enough to fill the pond and keep the water refreshed by letting it overflow.

Last year was the first time we tried grass carp in the pond. We hope that between the carp and removal of weeds from the surface, conditions will improve.

The SOA ponds at Lost Park Ranch were a problem last summer because there wasn't enough snowpack in the area to keep House Creek flowing into the ponds. Evaporation caused the water level to drop and as it got warmer, more weeds grew. TFC decided to forego stocking those ponds in late summer since conditions were not favorable for trout to survive.

This year could bring more of the same. Due to limited snow last winter, it is debatable if there is enough snowpack to sustain flow in House Creek this summer. We plan to place a few grass carp in the ponds in Lost Park because we understand the carp like the variety of weed growing there, but if the drought continues, we may again need to curtail some of our stocking.

**Tarryall Creek** conditions are dependent on snowpack for steady flow. This year, runoff may be insufficient to sustain adequate flow throughout the season. We will monitor conditions and stock when advisable.

#### **Grass Carp**



The grass carp that were stocked in the LPROA pond by Stagestop last year are a variety that does not reproduce. If you catch a grass carp, please return it to the pond. TFC would like to hear from you regarding the size of the carp you caught. Please send an e-mail message to news@tarryallfishingclub.net or call a board member.

# Antero Reservoir to be Drained For Drought Management


Denver Water, in coordination with Colorado Parks and Wildlife, will close Antero Reservoir on May 1 to drain the reservoir to save water supply during the ongoing drought. Antero Reservoir has the highest evaporation rate of any of Denver Water's reservoirs, so draining and storing the water in Cheesman and Eleven Mile reservoirs will reduce system evaporation losses by about 4,000 acre-feet. Beginning Wednesday, March 20, the bag and possession limit on trout at Antero will be increased from two to eight fish with no minimum size restriction. All other fishing regulations apply. I look forward to the up-coming fishing season and the fishing memories it will create.



## TFC Parking and Access Points—

TFC has specific access points for getting onto the river. See the map link on the home page of the TFC website, www.tarryallfishingclub.net for more detail or contact a board member.

- 1. Firehouse at Stagestop (uppermost point)
- 2. The LPROA water augmentation pond near Stagestop
- 3. Stream gage downstream from Rock Creek.
- Forest Service land next to Topaz Mountain Ranch road.
- State land before road to Lost Park Ranch (end of our fishing lease).

Caution: If you open a gate, close it behind you.

#### Who Can Use a Membership Card?

Membership cards are for the use of a lot owner (whose name is on the property deed) and a spouse or one other adult owner (whose name is on the property deed) – a maximum of two adults per lot.

If more than two adults own a lot, only two of the owners may use a membership card - all other owners must use guest passes.

Children, age 16 or under, do not need a guest pass but must be in the company of an adult with a membership card or guest pass.

#### Who Must Use a Guest Pass?

Anyone who is not entitled to use a membership card as defined above must use a guest pass.

When there are multiple owners of a single lot and more than two owners want to fish, the group of owners must decide among themselves who uses the two membership cards. All others must use guest passes.

#### TFC RULES VIOLATION POLICY

Owners are responsible for their guests and for insuring proper use of guest passes, including signing and dating in ink. Fines will be assessed against a lot for rules violations by the lot owner or lot owner's guests.

#### Penalties as follows:

- First violation: Warning letter
- Second violation: \$50 fine
- Third & subsequent violations: \$100 fine

A copy of the rules is sent out to all members each year with fishing passes. Rules are also posted on the TFC website www.tarryallfishingclub.net.

#### Fish Stocking Dates for 2013

The TFC website, www.tarryallfishingclub.net will list stocking dates as soon as known. Fish Stocking is done on a weekday as near the middle of the month as can be arranged. The first should be in mid-May.

#### "No Fishing" Days

**Fish Stocking days are no-fishing days.** Please refrain from fishing on stocking days to give the fish a chance to recover from the transport.

#### Fishing License Requirement.

Anyone over 16 years of age who fishes in the ponds or the stream lease is required to have a Colorado fishing license.

#### **Vehicle Hang Tag**

Each dues-paying lot is issued one vehicle hang tag. The hang tag is to be used in your vehicle while parked near the area you are fishing. A hang tag does not substitute for a membership card or a guest pass.

#### Patrolling for the TFC

Although Park County Sheriff Deputies will patrol for us some days, TFC will operate some patrol checkpoints and as always, members are encouraged to check passes while out fishing. It is a great way to meet fellow TFC members!

The TFC can use help with coordinating volunteers, checkpoint patrolling, and general work details.
